For All Students - General Personal Grooming – For both Male and Female students

- ensuring all buttons, flaps, sequins, etc. on clothing are secure
- ensuring clothing is clean

- Fingernails should be clean and trimmed, to avoid bits of fingernail breaking off into food, and to avoid accidentally tearing gloves and food packaging
- not wearing nail polish, artificial fingernails or other fingernail decorations
- for long nails, extra effort must be made to thoroughly wash under nails, which can trap dirt, faecal matter, etc.
- restraining hair by tying it back, using hairnets, beard restraints, bandannas, hats, etc.
- wearing no or a minimum amount of hair accessories
- ensuring any hair accessories worn are secure and/or covered (e.g. with a hair net)
- wearing no jewellery or a minimum amount of jewellery, especially on hands and wrists
- ensuring any jewellery worn is not loose
- if any jewellery is worn on hands or wrists, ensuring that extra effort is made to thoroughly clean under and around the jewellery
- wearing gloves over jewellery on hands
- not touching jewellery, especially jewellery in body piercings
- Shower daily and use deodorant.
- ensuring all dressings and bandages are secure and/or covered (e.g. with a glove)
- requires bandages and dressings on exposed parts of the body to be completely covered and waterproof
- ensuring phones being held in clothing are held securely
- avoiding using phones during food handling tasks
- if a phone is touched during food handling, ensuring hands are thoroughly cleaned afterwards
- Footwear must be in good repair, clean, comfortable and well-polished at all times.
- Sunglasses are to be removed when inside the function centre and training rooms
